A call for article abstracts for a special double issue of

The year 2025 will mark the 200th anniversary of the birth of Jean-Martin Charcot. *The Journal of the History of the Neurosciences* (<https://www.tandfonline.com/journals/njhn20>) plans a double issue that will celebrate the bicentennial anniversary of this seminal figure in the history of medicine and neurology, illustrate the range and robustness of current-day scholarship on Charcot, and foster continued research projecting into a third century of Charcot's legacy.
