




From the Airports (Fiumicino or Ciampino): Leonardo Express Train, or Taxi (50 euros)


From Termini Station: 20 min walk (km 1.5), bus 310, or taxi

Founded by Aldalberto Pazzini in 1938, relocated in 1954.



The museum is divided into three floors: the basement contains past dioramas; first floor is from prehistoric times to the 17th century; second floor from the 18th cent. to today.




