

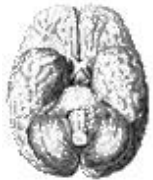

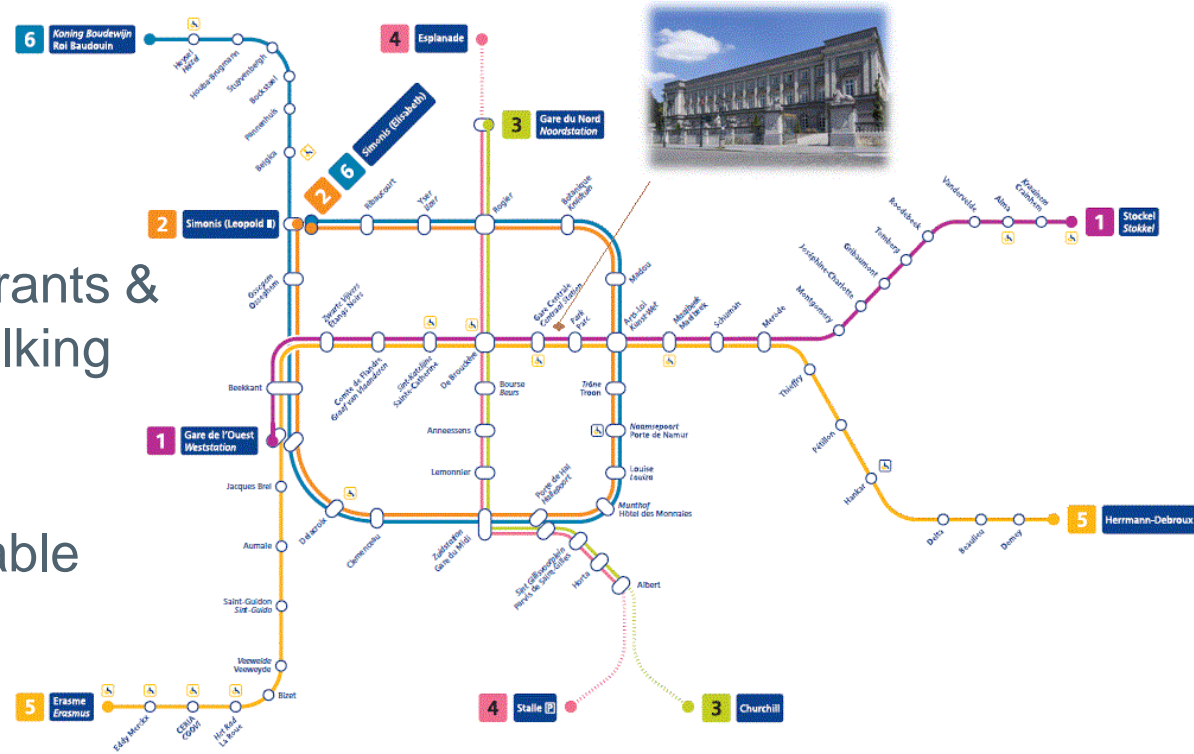

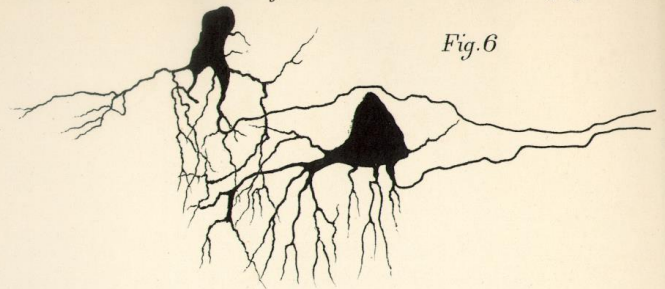

- Oldest Belgian University, founded in 1425, now split in 2 universities : UCLouvain & KULeuven

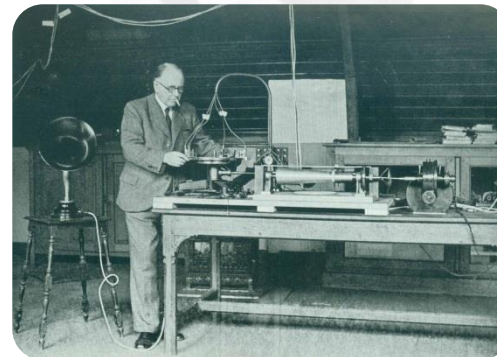
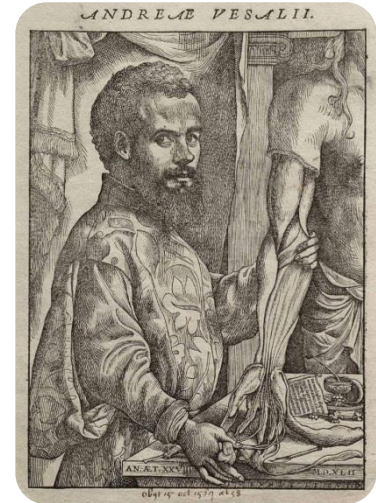
