The program is for UCLA undergraduate students who are currently working with UCLA CART faculty or have plans to work with UCLA CART faculty beginning this summer. This 8-10 week summer research position is designed to provide a rigorous, in-depth research experience for those interested in pursuing a career in autism spectrum disorder (ASD). Fields of potential study include both basic and clinical research, across disciplines including genetics, psychology, psychiatry, neuroscience, and education.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Undergraduate student currently enrolled at UCLA
- 8- 10 week availability

AWARD/COMPENSATION:

- Award/compensation of up to \$4,000 will be dispersed to the student.

- Applicants must submit:
 - A one-page personal statement that describes your:
 - Research and clinical experience, particularly as it pertains to autism
 - Motivation for this summer opportunity
 - Specific areas of interest.
 - CV
 - One letter of recommendation from the UCLA faculty with whom the student is requesting to work
