*Principal Investigators:

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Purpose of Study:

To examine the relationship between brain wave and body movement among children with and without Chronic Tic Disorders.

Participation:

- Cognitive Assessments, personal interviews, questionnaires
- Time commitment averages 3-4 hours
- Children will have their brain activity (EEG) recorded

Entrance Requirements:

- Children must be between 7 and 15 years of age
- Children must meet eligibility requirements for having a Chronic Tic Disorder or be typically developing.
