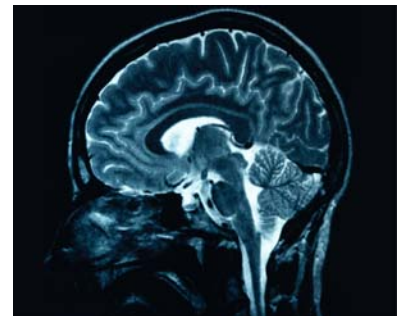
**Autism 2011 - Autism Spectrum Disorders:
