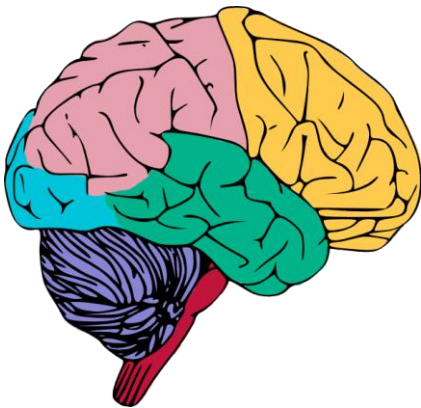
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- *Is your child between the ages of 8 and 13 years?*
